CHANGE IN FEES FOR MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS IN THE CITY OF MILLBRAE

Dear Property Owner/Management Company:

On December 29, 2014, the Central County Fire Department began a service agreement with the City of Millbrae to provide fire services to your community. As such, emergency response, fire prevention inspections and public education activities are now being performed by our department. Included in this service agreement is observance of the Central County Fire Department Fee Schedule for services performed. The fees for apartment buildings are different than those the City of Millbrae previously charged, and in some cases, are less.

Beginning in 2015, fire inspection and permit fees for multi-family residential (apartment) buildings are as follows:

Inspection Fees:

| Fourth and subsequent inspections: | \$335.00 for each inspection |

Annual permit:

| Building with 11-25 units: | \$218.00 |
| Building with 26 or more units: | \$308.00 |
